EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT:

Following is a partial list of items that the Commission may consider in coming months:

Within 3 Months:

1. LAFCO Service Reviews and Sphere of Influence Studies for the five Salinas Valley Cities – *September 2010*. This is part of Phase One of a comprehensive, multi-year work program to conduct service reviews and Sphere of Influence studies for all local agencies.
2. Monterey County Regional Fire Protection District/Carmel Valley Fire Protection District – Merger and Annexation – *October 2010*.

Within Six Months:

1. City of Gonzales – Comprehensive Sphere of Influence Amendment
2. Cities of Del Rey Oaks/Monterey/Seaside – Minor Boundary Adjustments.
3. City of Greenfield-County – LAFCO Memorandum of Agreement Relating to Sphere of Influence.
4. City of Salinas – Sphere of Influence Amendment and Annexation for Fresh Express.
5. City of Soledad – Sphere of Influence Amendment and Annexation for Miravale IIB Subdivision.

6. City of Soledad – Sphere of Influence Amendment and Annexation of US 101 Interchange at Front Street.
7. Aromas Water District – Sphere of Influence Amendment and Annexation of Oak Ridge / Via del Sol Area.
8. Marina Coast Water District – 220-Acre Armstrong Ranch Annexation (to facilitate water supply infrastructure).
9. Marina Coast Water District – Sphere of Influence and Annexation of Ord Community.
10. Pajaro/Sunny Mesa Community Services District - Pajaro County Sanitation District – Expansion of PSMCSD Boundaries and Dissolution of PCSD.
11. LAFCO Service Reviews and Sphere of Influence Studies for Monterey Peninsula Cities and Fire Protection Districts/Departments and Emergency Medical Service Providers – This will complete Phase One of a comprehensive, multi-year work program to conduct service reviews and Sphere of Influence studies for all local agencies.
