9.g Authorize Comments on the Initial Study and Negative Declaration for Aromas Water District's Sphere of Influence Amendment in San Benito County.

Vicki Morris, General Manager of the Aromas Water District, addressed the Commission regarding this item, and provided changes she requested to the comment letter. She added that the comment period has been extended from July 9th to the 21st in order to allow additional time for review and comments.

Chair Champion opened this item for public comment.

Public Comment

Margie Kay, North Monterey County resident, urged inclusion of language encouraging further CEQA review in the comment letter.

Commission Comments and Action

Commission discussed the comment letter with General Counsel Girard.

Upon motion of Commissioner Rubio, seconded by Commissioner Gourley, Item 9.g was trailed to item 13 on the Agenda in order to allow General Counsel Girard time to modify the comment letter prior to Commission Action.

9.h Approve Appointment of Special District Member to Budget and Finance Committee.

Chair Champion announced his recommendation of Commissioner Tom Moore as the Special District member on the Budget and Finance Committee

Item 10: New Business

10.a Consider Resolution to Adopt Miscellaneous Revisions to Policies and Procedures Relating to Spheres of Influence and Changes of Organization and Reorganization, Including a Finding that the Revisions are not a Project for Purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act (Recommended by the Sphere of Influence and Annexation Policy Committee on June 16, 2010).

Executive Officer McKenna provided a report. Committee Chair DiMaggio briefly expanded on the report adding that efforts were made by Executive Officer McKenna to keep the community informed of the proposed revisions and additions to the policies and procedures relating to Spheres of Influence and changes of organization and reorganization.

Chair Champion opened this item for public comment.

Public Comments

Steve McHarris, Community Development Director, City of Soledad, said that the cities agree with the clean up revisions to the policies. However, they have concerns with the revised preliminary Sphere of Influence review policy & the new policy on Housing and Jobs.

Amy White, Executive Director, Landwatch, spoke in favor of the new policies and early involvement as part of the application process.

Bill Farrell, Community Development Director, City of Gonzales, on behalf of Rene Mendez, City Manager, expressed concerns over the preliminary Sphere of Influence and Housing/Jobs policies.

Vanessa Vallarta, Attorney, City of Salinas, requested time for further review by the public and the LAFCO Sphere of Influence and Annexation Policy Committee.

Chair Champion closed public comment period for this item.

Commission Comments and Action

Commissioner Calcagno, discussed benefits of early involvement with LAFCO as part of the application process. He said that he would support a continuance of this item to work on modification of language, but that he is not willing to remove the language.

Commissioner Gourley, requested continuation of this item to one or two Policy Committee meetings with increased involvement with the cities in the process.

Commissioner Rubio, requested continuance of this item to allow more time for Policy Committee to interact with the cities, address their concerns, and allow them to provide suggestions for modified language.

Commissioner Stephens, addressed concerns with cities' staffing constraints.

Commissioner Salinas, requested passing the non-substantive changes, at this time, and continuing the new policies for further discussion and involvement with the cities.

Commissioner Calcagno, respectfully disagreed with Commissioner Salinas and asked that the non-substantive revisions not be taken separately.

Commissioner Darington added that he supports providing guidance to cities as part of early involvement with the application process.

Upon motion of Commissioner Calcagno, seconded by Commissioner Rubio, this item was referred back to the LAFCO Sphere of Influence and Annexation Policy Committee to primarily discuss the preliminary Sphere of Influence review and Housing/Jobs policies, allowing the cities a further opportunity to participate and work on language that will bring LAFCO and the cities to a mutual understanding.

Item 11: Executive Officer's Report

Executive Officer McKenna reported on the upcoming 2010 CALAFCO Annual Conference.

There were no public comments for this informational item.

Item 12: Correspondence

There was one item of correspondence included with the meeting packet - Letter from Tom Carvey, President/CEO of the Salinas Valley Chamber of Commerce – May 14, 2010.

There were no additional items of correspondence or public comments for this informational item.

Item 13 – Continuation of Item 9.g Pulled from Consent Agenda

Authorize Comments on the Initial Study and Negative Declaration for Aromas Water District's Sphere of Influence Amendment in San Benito County.

Chair Champion requested General Counsel Girard to provide his recommendations for modification of the comment letter.

Upon motion of Commissioner Gourley, seconded by Commissioner Calcagno, the comment letter as revised by General Counsel Girard was unanimously approved.
